



Clue #1... gather your supplies **The first card is Portrait Style... measurements included for Landscape!**
 All measurements in inches.

READ CAREFULLY PLEASE (Do NOT hesitate to ask any questions)

Colored Card Stock (ALL SAME COLOR):

- 1 @ 4-1/4 x 11 Scored long side @ 5-1/2 **PLUS...** move a smidgeon to right and make a 2nd score line*
- 1 @ 7-3/4 x 8 Scored on 7-3/4 side @ 3 + 3-3/4 + 4-1/2 + 7-1/2 (SEE PICTURE)
- 1 @ 1 x 11 for belly band

* I added a SECOND score to give it a bit of a fold to allow for a thicker layer for the "wave"

Designer Series Paper (DSP) :

- 1 @ 4 x 5-1/4 (**OR CAN USE** coordinating cardstock)

White/Vanilla Card Stock:

- 1 @ 4 x 5-1/4

Die Cuts, Embellishments, Stamps:

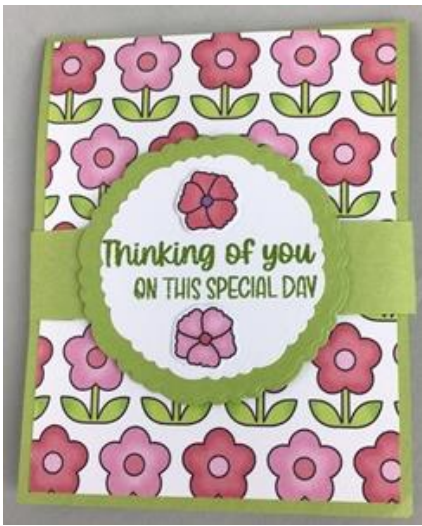
- 8-10 misc. sizes of die-cuts... small to large
- 2 circles to layer for front; 1 @ approx. 1-3/4 + 2

Other Supplies:

- **PAPER CUTTER** + grid paper and/or cutting mat (opt)
- **Tear tape OR Glue**, stamps (for optional background stamping) and ink

JUST A REMINDER... I may or may not use items shown.... just sayin'... lol!



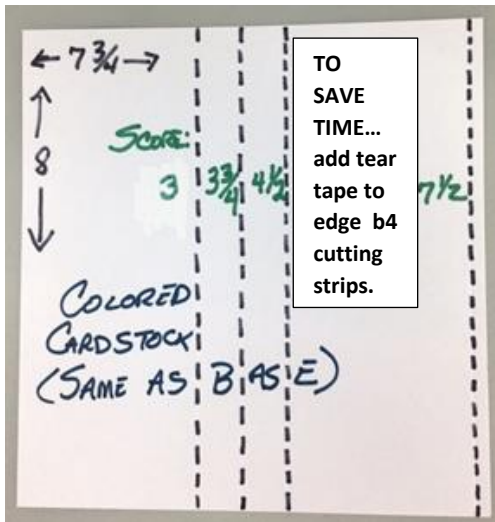


The Stamps of Life supplies: posie2stamp, patterns4posies, So Kind Collection Pad, Kiwi, Deckle Edge Shapes Bundle.

Stampin' Up! supplies: Winter Owls & Dies (coming S@@N in the 2023 Holiday Mini), Evergreen Forest 3D Embossing Folder (retired), Crumb Cake, Pecan Pie, Stylish Shapes Dies.

DIRECTIONS:

NOTE: I may have changed out colored CS to help demo purposes.



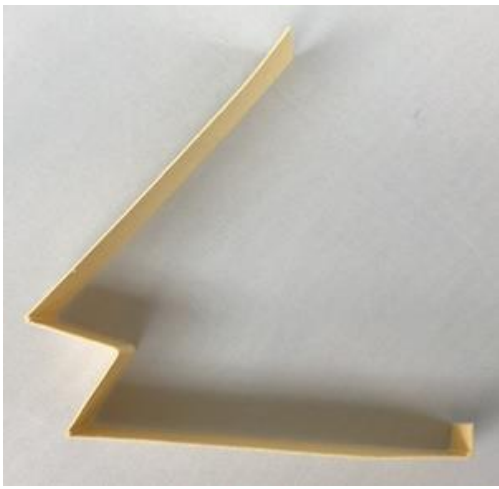
1 – Turn your card to the 8 side and cut 8 strips at 1 each. You now have 8 strips at 1” x 7-3/4 each. **SAVE TIME...** I also folded this piece to help make the process easier... mountain, valley, mntn, mntn. If the score tape goes over the edge, no problem... you can fold over any excess when attaching.



2 – Add 1/4 tear tape to each end. **TO SAVE TIME...** add your tear tape BEFORE cutting strips.



3 – Fold under tear tape end.
4 – Fold back in half.



5 – Now make a tall “W” by folding outside folds up as shown.

6 – Adhere tear tape to opposite end. Folded end is “top”.



7 – When stood up, each strip should now look as shown... like a tent.

8 – Add one strip of tear tape near left side of “top”, but no more than middle of strip.

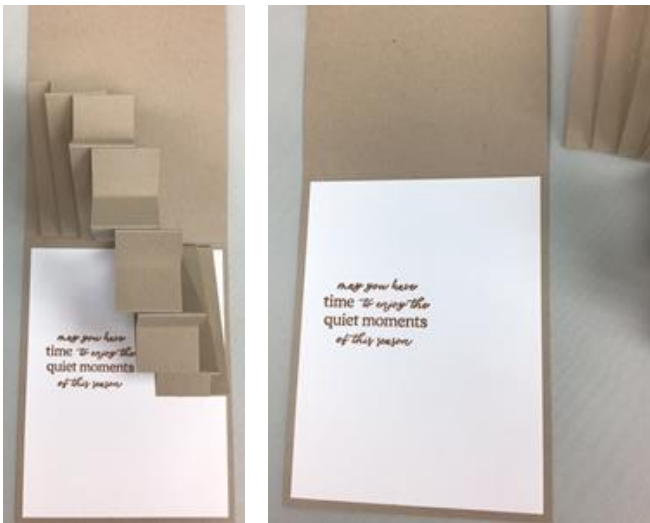


9 – I like to use my grid mat to line up, adhering about 2/3’s across the first folded strip and then each one thereafter, until all 8 strips are adhered together.

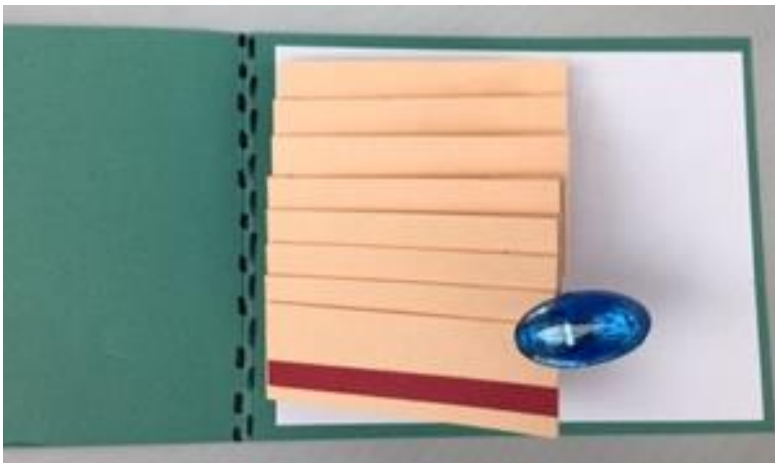
10 – When all 8 strips are done, check to make sure they will fit inside of your folded base, being no wider than 4 inches. Then add a second strip of tear tape on the far left strip as shown.



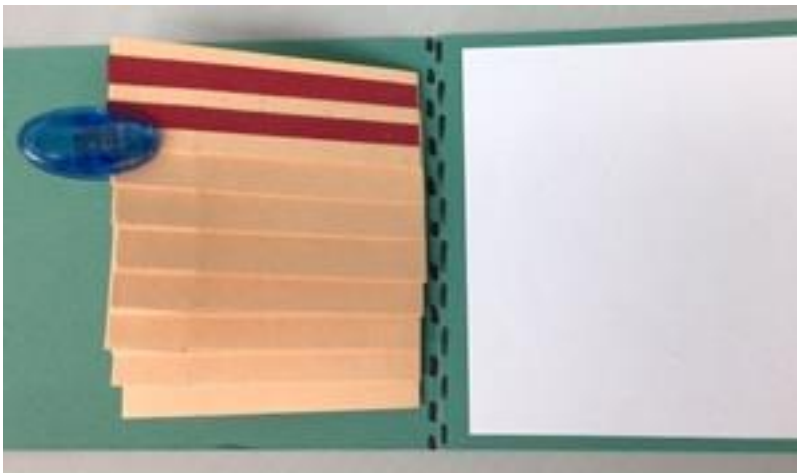
11 – Flip up and over; add two strips of tear tape to far right end strip. I’ve also shown what it looks like standing up on tent-fold ends from the top.



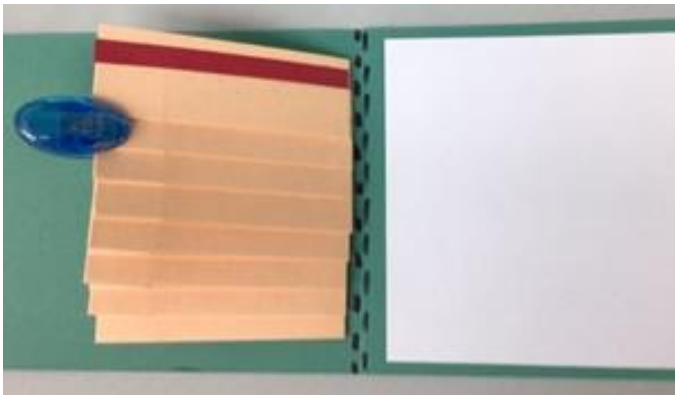
NOW IS ALSO A GOOD TIME to stamp your inside of your card before adhering to your base. I eyeball where my wave is going to be on my card; set the wave to one side and stamp your message.



12 – Since this “wave” is really bulky, I do NOT just lay on top and fold my front base over entire wave... it tends to move on me. But instead do this... remove protection on the inside of the 2 strips.



13 – Flip over; line up “wave” (where you want it to lay) about 1/8 from fold; keep edge straight with edge of base; adhere. Lift up and remove 2nd protection and adhere. Lift up tent to burnish tear tape.



14 – Repeat for other edge of “wave”. This picture (right) distorted the top... make sure to focus on the bottom of picture to see where I lined up the other side of the “wave” with the edge of my white layer PLUS adhered it to the top of my white layer.

Wha-la!!! Embellish as desired! Enjoy! It’s YOUR card... lol! Make it your way!
